

To ensure patients presenting to the University Hospital Emergency Department and current inpatients who have been administered a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) are easily identified, Barwon Health will be rolling out yellow Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) stickers across key areas in the acute campus from 11 February 2022. An example of the sticker is below:

The stickers will be available from areas where RATs are obtained. For the majority of areas, this will be from the Access and Resource team.

The stickers should be completed once a result has been received and placed in the patient progress notes.

These stickers will be rolled out across University Hospital Geelong only at this stage. Other sites should clearly document the administration of a RAT, including date and result, in their progress notes.

Stickers will be allocated according to projected test numbers. If you require more yellow Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) stickers or have any questions, please call COVID response manager Emma Jones on 0432 646 321.

Please note, this documentation method is for RATs only and does not apply to COVID-19 PCR tests, the results of which must be documented by hand in the patient progress notes.
